The Socialist Party opposed this war from day one and calls for the immediate withdrawal of all troops now.

As part of this effort the National Committee endorsed the ongoing "Iraq Moratorium" actions that are held on the third Friday of every month and has initiated a Socialist Party Anti-Imperialism Committee. DUES RATE CHANGES ON MAY 2, 2008

The following dues rate changes will start on May 2, 2008 **Full time student rates** will be an introductory rate for new members only.
